



Aloha!

It's time to break out the sticks again on Maui and we are so ready to have you back at Maui Nui Golf Club. We've been preparing for this day for weeks and have put protocols into place to make sure that your safety and the safety of our team members is the top priority. We all have a part to play in making sure that your experience at Maui Nui is fun, friendly, and safe.

Below are the guidelines from the Government regarding what you need to do to keep yourself, your fellow golfers and your Maui Nui team safe. We've also included some of the steps we are taking to ensure your well-being.

Here's what you can expect from us:

The state and local government along with the Aloha Section Professional Golf Association (PGA) have asked us to adhere to the following guidelines and we are happy to do it because you really do matter to us and we want to take care of you.

#### CARTS

We are limiting our riding cart availability to one person per cart unless you are playing with a family member who lives with you. Be prepared to show us your ID so that we can verify both players' addresses. We will provide you with a flag for your cart when verified. Carts will be washed and sanitized after each use. Of course, you can walk 18 or nine when available!

#### DRIVING RANGE AND PRACTICE AREAS

Feel free to warm up before your round and practice at the range. You can use the range up to 20-minutes prior to your tee time. Please remain at least 6-feet apart on the range with no more than 10 people at one time. You may use the first-tee putting green maximum of 5-10 minutes prior to play also remaining at least 6-feet apart. Buckets and balls will be sanitized before and after each use. Club fitting and golf instruction are by appointment only with strict social distancing. Need to work on your short game? Practice greens and chipping areas at the range are open but limited to 10 people at one time.



#### OUTSIDE SERVICES

We are not allowed to handle your golf bags for you in any way. You'll need to carry your bag from the parking lot to your cart or feel free to use the bag drop.

#### CLUBHOUSE

The clubhouse is closed. No indoor gathering is allowed so no food and beverage will be available inside. However, we will provide some limited grab-and-go items on the golf course at certain times. Bathroom use is allowed with single occupancy. We will be providing soap and water and hand sanitizer in each restroom and we will be sanitizing frequently throughout the day. All other indoor events are canceled until further notice.

#### RESTROOMS/LOCKER ROOMS

We're going to be cleaning and disinfecting our restrooms regularly. You may use the restrooms inside, but please practice social distancing. The locker rooms are not available to store your equipment, clothes, changing, or showering. Restroom use only.

#### BEV CART

We plan to have a beverage cart on the golf course on a limited basis. You should bring your own water or take advantage of our grab-and-go service. So come prepared to keep yourself hydrated.

#### LEAGUES, GROUP PLAY, AND TOURNAMENTS

All leagues, group play, and tournaments have been temporarily suspended until we get the all-clear from Maui County.

#### INTERVALS

Our tee time intervals will be set at 12-minutes to encourage and ensure social distancing. Please do not get bunched up or gather on tee boxes or greens.

#### MAKING TEE TIMES

We encourage you to book your tee times online and to utilize our new, prepaid options to limit face-to-face transactions. We want to keep it fun and friendly, but we want to keep you safe too!

We'd like to ask you to help us by following the guidelines below.



## **Things you can do include:**

### WHEN TO ARRIVE

Be sure not to show up any earlier than 20-minutes before your tee time. This will help us avoid groups congregating around the teeing area and common areas. Please only have one person from your group check-in.

### NO BAG SERVICE

Remember, you are going to have to carry your own bag to and from the car and the cart. Be prepared. Travel light.

### FLAGSTICKS

Please do not touch or remove flagsticks from the cups at any time (any putts that hit the swimming "noodle" or similar device used to fill the hole or the cup, will be considered holed).

### RAKES

You'll notice we pulled all our rakes out of the bunkers. Either stay out of the bunkers :- ) or please smooth your footprints and divot using your feet.

### THE OFFICIAL WORD

When playing, golfers should maximize physical distance per CDC Guidelines at <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/prevent-getting-sick/prevention-H.pdf>  
You'll need to stay at least six (6) feet apart at all times, our staff will be swinging by to make sure everyone is following this guideline.

### SHOES AND SANITIZER

Please change shoes in the parking lot and bring your own hand sanitizer as well.

### TIME TO GO

We love having you play with us, but you gotta go home when you're done. Please do not congregate after play and leave upon completion of play to eliminate congestion and gathering.
